

“Right decision” to build a Kiwi Shed - Peter Valley

“I’m glad we went to Kiwi Sheds, I believe we made the right decision when we decided to build our new shed,” says Peter Valley of Peter J Valley Drainlayers Ltd of Pukekohe.

Peter, who has been in business for 10 years, has had a six year association with Kiwisheds through being involved in drag racing at the Meremere dragstrip.

Peter’s recently completed shed is 30 metres by 20 metres with steel portals and coloursteel cladding and is the new headquarters for Peter J Valley Drainlayers. The shed has five by six metre bays to house his six trucks and four diggers. It also includes downstairs offices and an upstairs smoko room.

The project was carried out by local contractors and the site, which fits inside an area fenced by John Michie, was dug out by Peter and his team. The concrete floor was laid by Wayne Callender and the office and smoko room were built by Martinovich Builders, with the electrical work installed by Beston Electrical.

Peter is extremely pleased with the final result, despite the project being hampered by the weather.

“It was a little frustrating at times as the weather delayed the building process,” says Peter, “but Kiwisheds were right on to it when they were able and the actual building time took only about six weeks.”

Peter J Valley Drainlayers Ltd is a small family business, owned by Peter and his wife, Brenda, with a close-knit staff headed by operations manager, Neil Dudley, foreman Braden Kaio, and nine others.
